General Information

1. Make checks or money orders payable to **White Fences Equestrian Center, Inc.** and mail with a completed 2008 DIFOPL entry form (from the Blue Book) and copy of a negative Coggins report (dated no earlier than **one year prior to show**) to the Secretary/Manager at address above. No exhibitor will be permitted to enter the show unless all fees are paid in full. Credit cards are **NOT** accepted.
2. **IMPORTANT NOTE: These are two separate 1-day shows. Separate entry forms, with all fees, must be sent for each day!**
3. Please state on entry form if riding Adult Amateur, Open, or GAIG/USDF Qualifying.
4. **Entries** must be **received** by the closing date. **DO NOT SEND ENTRIES REGISTERED OR SIGNATURE REQUIRED.** If a signature is required, the entry will not be claimed. **No telephone or fax entries accepted.** Any entry RECEIVED after the closing date is a Post Entry and may be accepted at the discretion of the show secretary.
5. The Entry Form must include three **ORIGINAL** signatures – photocopied signatures are **not** permitted. **Photocopies of USEF & USDF Membership Cards and Horse Registration forms, for the Rider, Owner, Trainer and Coach must be attached for ALL entries.**
6. Management reserves the right to split, cancel, or combine the classes or to add or substitute judges or make any changes required by circumstances. In the event of over-subscription, a waiting list will be established. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first served basis in accordance with Article 1502.9a of the USEF Rules. **No-shows will be considered a scratch for the remainder of the show.**
7. **GAIG/USDF Qualifying:** If entering as GAIG Qualifying, copies of USEF and USDF membership cards for both rider and owner and copies of USEF Lifetime or Annual Horse Recording and the USDF full lifetime horse registration **must** be included with entry.
8. Non-negotiable (bounced) checks will void the entry and incur a \$50.00 charge plus bank fees. The entry will be placed on a waiting list until a money order, certified check or cash is received.
9. **Awards:** Six ribbons in each class. Champion and Reserve ribbons awarded for the high score at each level each day. The Dover Medal will be awarded to a second level adult amateur for high score of the show at **Refunds:** Refunds less office fee prior to closing date. **No refund of entry fees after closing date for any that level.**
10. **Times & Acknowledgments:** Tentative times may be obtained via the Internet at: www.dressagedaily.com. In addition, tentative times will be mailed 1 week prior to the show. **Official** times will be posted at the office at 12 noon the day prior to the show. Only the times posted at the office should be considered **official!!**
11. Two 20 x 60 m. sand-based competition rings. Two 20 x 60 m. sand-based warm-up rings. Ample grass areas also available for warm-up. Longeing in round pen only, please, and one horse at a time!
12. **EMT** will be on showgrounds during competition hours. Vet and Farrier on call throughout the weekend.
13. **Hospitality:** Breakfast and lunch will be provided to riders on the day(s) they are showing. Saturday evening "Welcome Back" party will begin approximately 1 hour following last ride of the day.
14. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices.
15. **Measurements**, if required, must be prearranged and will be by appointment only.
16. **Other:** USEF rules go into effect upon arrival at the show grounds. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. All dogs must be leashed with a maximum 6 ft. lead. **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED!** A veterinarian and a farrier will be on call (or on site) during show hours. An EMT will be present at the showgrounds. All emergency numbers will be posted at the office tent and in the show program. Bridle numbers must be worn at all times when a horse is out of the trailer.
17. **Directions:** Located in the White Fences Community. From the Florida Turnpike or Route I-95 (North or South), exit at Southern Boulevard and head west to Seminole Pratt Whitney Rd. Turn right, heading north. At light at Sycamore Dr., turn left, heading west. Follow to stop sign, then turn left into White Fences on Horse Trail Rd. At Y, bear left onto Hanover Circle. At next Y, bear left onto Buck Ridge Trail. Trailer parking is allowed along fence line of showgrounds. Personnel will be available to assist with parking, if needed.
18. **Accommodations:** The Royal Inn, Royal Palm Beach – 561-793-3000; Hampton Inn, Wellington Green Mall – 561-792-2361.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes. 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
